So...Waiotauru Hut Announcement

ARAC is delighted to announce that an application for funding to rebuild the Waiotauru Hut has been provisionally approved by the New Zealand Outdoor Recreation Consortium. The amount totals \$16,435 which goes most of the way to demolish and then build a new hut. (See http://www.hutsandtracks.org.nz/resources for more details on NZORC)

You may recollect from previous Newsletters that the Tararua Aaorangi Rimutaka Hut Committee (TARH) has already allocated an addition \$6,000 contingency should we require it. Naturally we will not draw from TARH unless we have to.

The funding is dependent on ARAC completing the formal management agreement for the Hut with DOC – in progress at this time.

Watch for further announcements this summer as we complete the adoption process then put out the call for volunteers to help with the actual demolition and construction.
